It looks as though the 'season of mist and yellow fruitfulness' is well and truly upon us and we're replacing our summer plants with carved pumpkins, cobwebs and broomsticks. Despite the ups and downs of the weather, Summer at the Centre was filled with fun and laughter and we thank you all for your support throughout the holiday season.

Autumn is a time of repair, refurbishment and development for us this year, with a number of major products in the pipeline for the coming weeks and months. Our recent online auction raised over €7k, a welcome addition to the funds needed for our refurbishment projects. We were pleased to announce during the Summer months that we had been allocated over €33k through the Community Climate Action Programme, managed by Wexford Council. The funds will be used to add PV solar panels to the Centre roof, provide efficient sensor lighting in our hallways and a new lighting system in our Main sports hall. We have also invested in some new trees for our grounds and reusable equipment for use in our Tea Room. So the future's looking brighter – and greener!

We were also awarded a Sports Capital grant of €157, 801; these funds have been assigned to the refurbishment of our running track, and we look forward to offering you a top class facility in 2025.

Our third Christmas market will take place on Sunday 8 December (2-6pm). Many stallholders have already secured their spot and will offer homemade goodies, festive garlands and table decorations, wax melts, stationery and much more. It's a perfect opportunity to enjoy our Christmas garden and seasonal refreshments will be available at the Garden Café.
