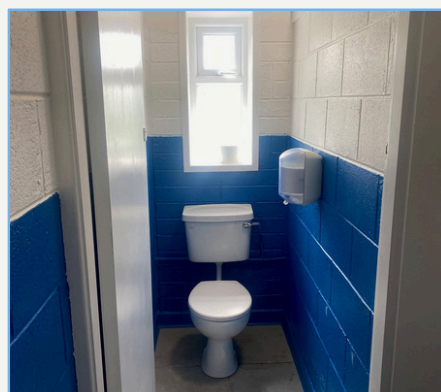
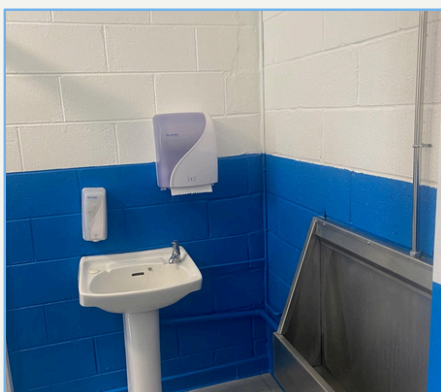


Sports Capital

2024 allowed us to focus on rebuilding and replacing different areas of the centre. We completed our Sports Capital Grant funding with the installation of a new fuse board for the centre (€15322.50) and new team dugouts on the playing field (€7830.00). We were delighted to secure further funding from Sports Capital of €157801, which will go towards replacing the running/walking track in 2025.

Community Climate Action Programme

In July 24 we were delighted to be awarded €33533.55 for the supply and installation of 22.5kW Solar PV installation, replace existing lighting in changing rooms, corridor and sports hall with new LED sensor lighting, six apple trees to grow in our orchard near the playground and reusable equipment for our Tea Room. This project will commence in 2025. We need to replace and repair our main sports hall roof before solar works and lighting can proceed, we would appeal to everyone to make a donation to assist with funding this project.



Men's Toilets

In spring we renovated the men's toilets on a shoestring budget. We removed the old urinals and installed a stainless steel trough, replaced toilets, cubical doors, full repaint and installed a new tiled floor.

Events Programme

Every year the staff work extremely hard in securing a variety of camps to come to Rosslare to ensure the summer holidays are one to remember. We held many events such as the Teddy Bear's Picnic, Family Bingo, Rosslare Golf Classic and the Annual Summer Fest. The Family Colour Run made a return which was topped off with a treat of Strawberries & Ice Cream which was kindly sponsored by Howden Insurance and Scúp.

Community Sheds

After long delays waiting on our commencement notice our community sheds are really starting to take shape. Our roof is on, internal and external walls are stacking up every day and the windows and doors will arrive early in the new year. This will be a fantastic facility for all of the community. The workshop can reopen and our community groups will have space to create and organise. It will house all our mowers and community tractor and the maintenance team will have a new home to discuss the running of the village!! We will have to continue to fundraise next year for fit out to make it suitable for all users. We promise, the wait will be worth it.
